HOW TO COME TO LONGI

Longi is 18 km away from the junction of Rocca di Capri Leone of the A20 Palermo-Messina motorway. To reach the country you need to travel, then, the 157 P.S.. If you travel by train you can get off at the station Sant'Agata di Militello (27 km) or in that of Capo d'Orlando (km 26). The nearest airports are the one of "Filippo Eredia" in Catania - Fontanarossa, 190 Km from Longi and that of "Falcone-Borsellino" in Palermo at about 170 Km.

If you go to Longi you can't miss the Nebrodi's Adventure Park. It is composed by 5 itinerary, based on the height and on the age of the person who have to do the itinerary. It's the first adventure park in the province of Messina and It's a pleasant and entertainment way to discover the nature's beauties and the Nebrodi's landscapes.



Longi is a small village situated over Nebrodi's mountains. It's located at 620 m above sea level in a territory where the natural beauties mix with the landscape ones. The village is dominated by the Crasto's Rocks which are usually covered with snow in winter. You can't miss the principal feasts which are the Black Pig Village Festival on January the 5TH, the SS. Crocifisso's feast on August the 23TH and "U Scontru" on Easter. If you want to enjoy yourself, you have to come in Longi!



There are a lot of other places worth visiting in Longi, like the Mangalaviti's houses, the Catafurco falls and many other. Don't forget to come to Longi, one of "the mushroom villages"!



The Longi's gorge is one of the most interesting natural places in Sicily. It's a very deep gorge dug out over time by the river Fitalia where you can do guided canyoning. The site is very important because it put up to many species of birds of prey and tipical plants.
